- 1 Saxon T Mini Dobsonian telescope [with large dust cap]; a focuser [with small dust cap, 3 silver screws and two wheels]; finderscope [with two screws] and Saxon tabletop mount with lock nut
- 4 Eye pieces [H20mm, SR4mm, Super 10mm, Super 25mm lenses]
- 1 Moon filter
- 1 Lens cloth
- 1 Astronomical Software Disc
- 1 MiniDob instruction manual
- 1 1L Sistema container
- 1 40L Sistema container
- 1 Display card
